Subject: WIA Enrollment Guidelines

Effective Date: May 1, 2002

Purpose: To establish guidelines on when to enroll and begin tracking Region 4 WIA customers.

References: Section 134(d)(2) of the Workforce Investment Act and 20 CFR Part 662.240 of the Workforce Investment Act.

Background: The Workforce Investment Act states adults and dislocated workers who receive services funded under title I other than self-service or informational activities must be registered and determined eligible.

Policy: It is the policy of the WIB-MOV that when a WIA Title I staff-assisted service that is part of an ongoing relationship or plan shall require registration in the "WorkForce West Virginia" system and will count toward the core performance measures, as outlined in the Governor's Workforce Investment Division Policy on Point of Registration Requirements for Services Under Title 1B of the Workforce Investment Act.

Action: The WorkForceWV will be informed of this policy.

Expiration Date: This policy shall be in effect until revised or canceled by the Workforce Investment Board Mid-Ohio Valley.
